The number of participants from both countries will be limited to the first 25 of each country, who will fill the google form.

*deadline has been extended in Japan until 20th May. Application up to 25 people is accepted on the first-come, first served basis.

- (2) You will receive an invitation E-mail from Polito Japan Hub around at 30th April, 2024, with a .ppt template (max 5 pages) for your presentation
- (3) Upload PDF-converted presentation, by 7th June (Fri), through a second Google Form that will be communicated in the invitation





- (4) Address of the Google Drive folder in which all posters are saved will be announced to all participants 1-week earlier than the event so that participants can know other people's contents in advance.
- (5) For group discussion time, after the presentations, several thematic rooms will be arranged according to the number of participants and their talk themes.
- (6) Zoom link will be announced to all participants 1-week earlier than the event

- Acceptable **maximum number of slides** of .ppt presentation **is 5**, **size of PDF-converted** presentation is **10Mbytes**.
- By considering the aim of the event, presenters do not need to present brand-new contents. Contents in previous presentations can be used. Please introduce yourself!
